- It is also the case...

When you want to be sure you are showing how the evidence proves your point:

- This illustrates/demonstrates/reveals that...
- What this makes clear is...
- What this evidence suggests is...
- While this may be true...
- Despite this...
- The evidence points to...
- and by doing so...

When you want to be fair to counter argument:

- It is true that...
- There are cases where...
- It is important to acknowledge that ...
- There may be some conditions under which....
- Now some argue...
